Suggested Homework Activities:

Reading- we encourage a book to be read at least 3 times, once for decoding, twice for comprehension and thirdly for fluency.

RWI Sound Book- recap reading and writing sounds learnt in school.

Year 1 Spellings/ Reception Red word keyrings-Please practise reading and writing these as much as possible to help with reading and writing progress.

Reading Eggs and Maths Seeds- Please continue to encourage your child to engage with these activities at least once a week.

Not all activities must be completed every day. I would suggest 2 activities for a maximum of 15 minutes.
