The statutory Phonics Screening will take place for our Year One pupils on Thursday 13th of June and Friday 14th June. We will be administering the assessment on a 1:1 basis in a quiet environment. You will be informed of the result in your child's end of year school report. If your child does not pass, they will resit the screening in Year Two.
