Newsletter for 6th September 2024

Attendance:

It's been great to have everyone back and in school in time to learn. Please see the attachment with a letter from the local authority regarding attendance and consider this if you're looking at term-time holidays. Cumbria has been slow in the past compared to other counties to issue fines so a national approach is now in place. The local authority have access to school registers and will monitor absences remotely.

'If your child misses school without a good reason, the local authority can intervene and you may be issued with a fine.

From September 2024, the Department for Education has introduced a new national framework which means that the same rules apply to all schools. Under the new framework, all schools are required to consider a fine when a child misses 10 or more sessions (five days) for unauthorised reasons. If the absence is for an unauthorised holiday in term time, you could be issued with a fine. From August 2024 the amount of the fine is increasing to £80 if paid within 21 days or £160 if paid within 28 days. If a second fine is issued for the same child within a three year period the amount will be £160. These fines are per child, per parent.'
